



# DEFENSE LOGISTICS AGENCY

As the nation's combat logistics support agency, the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) manages the global supply chain – from raw materials to end user to disposition – for the Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard, 10 combatant commands, other federal agencies, and partner and allied nations. The agency is responsible for contracting, purchasing, storing and distributing most of the consumable, expendable and repairable items America's military forces need to operate, from food, fuel and energy, to uniforms, medical supplies, and construction equipment. DLA also supplies nearly 86 percent of the military's spare parts. In addition, the agency manages the reutilization of military equipment, provides catalogs and other logistics information products, and offers document automation and production services. DLA is headquartered at Fort Belvoir, Va. As a global enterprise, wherever the United States has a significant military presence, DLA is there to support.

The DLA director reports to the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition and Sustainment through the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Sustainment.
